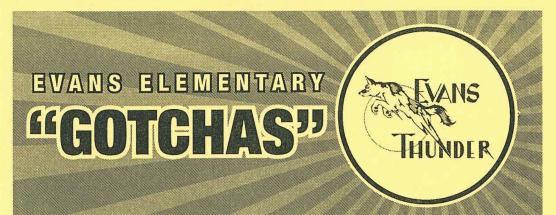


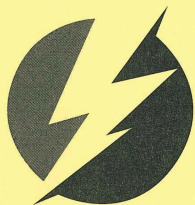

CLASSROOM (Library, Gym, Music Room, Computer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate Powerful Listening of the Teacher, EAs and others • Be considerate of others' learning time • Use class time wisely • Use manners & appropriate language • Follow the Dress Code 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow directions of the teachers/ EAs/SAs • Be a Powerful listener • Be willing to learn from your mistakes • Use class time wisely • Do your best and keep trying • Wear indoor shoes • Chair - 4 on the floor • Help keep the classroom clean and tidy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set an example for others to follow; lead by example not by correcting • Show our guests a great day by being extra helpful • Keep tools and supplies in the proper space • Use your planner daily • Complete and hand in assignments and homework on time 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to the teacher/presenter • Be willing to learn from others' ideas • Help others when asked or when you see someone in need • Share materials • Take turns Be positive & kind <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Think and ask questions • Focus on your learning and work Ask for help when needed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use complimentary language • Listen to your teacher; listen to others • Say things that encourage others • Let others go first
PLAYGROUND	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to the supervisors • Listen to others' problem solving words • Put garbage in bins • Use manners & appropriate language • Respect others & their ideas 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow Hands Off/Feet Off Rule • Try to solve a problem first, before seeking adult help • Return equipment you use • Stay in assigned areas (Primary on Primary Playground, Intermediate students on assigned field; follow hockey and b-ball schedules...) • Bring in equipment that you have taken out 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Volunteer to be a peer playground helper • Play fairly- following the rules of the game • Take turns and wait your turn in line-ups • Help push others on our new equipment • Include others • Remember the Golden Rule • Be a Positive Leader; try not to target individuals in "put out" games 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn from your mistakes • Play games that challenge your skills to be better • Try to do a variety of games/activities to learn new things • Make an effort to include others • Pick up equipment even if it doesn't belong to you 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make an effort to include others who need friends on the playground • Play games in the spirit of fun not to win • Say complimentary things
HALLWAYS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep hands & feet to self • Remove wet shoes & any hats at the outside door • Hallway Work: Work quietly, clean up after yourself and push in your chair • Walk around adults in conversation 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk facing forward • Keep hands and feet to yourself • Walk quietly • Look (at displays) with your eyes not with hands Don't push, shove or budge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Greet others and return Greetings (quietly) • Welcome and assist visitors to our school • Demonstrate pride in our school by tidying up and moving quietly in the halls 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk on the right side of the hallway in single file • Go directly to where you need to be • Line up in single file • Wait quietly in a line outside classrooms or where work is happening until invited in 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be polite in the hallway • Make eye contact and smile, and greet when required • Walk on the right side of the hallway
LUNCH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to the supervisors • Talk quietly with others • Eat your own lunch and take home any leftovers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wash hands before eating • Clean up spills immediately • Stay seated until dismissed • At the bell, clean off your desk & go outside Use the washroom during playtime	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to Supervision Assistants & monitors • Bring a healthy lunch • Use good manners & appropriate Language 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When dismissed put garbage, recyclables, and lunch bag away • On "In Days": choose an appropriate activity, use inside voices & clean up when the bell rings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use inside voices • Clean up after yourself when the bell goes • Be friendly and courteous to all supervisors; adults and student leaders

WASHROOM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flush the toilet • Wash hands • Take proper care of the facility • Respect privacy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wash hands with soap • Turn off taps when finished • Keep washroom tidy • Leave food & school supplies in the classroom • Do what you need to do, and then leave 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leave it tidy for others • Wait your turn quietly • Use quiet voices • Attempt to solve problems with learned skills; report problems to a teacher/ supervisor if further support is required 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage others to use the space appropriately • Go during breaks • Use the washroom quickly & quietly • Clean up after yourself 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take turns • Make your visit quick • Give people their privacy
ASSEMBLY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing "O Canada" respectfully, hands at your side, facing the flag • Sit quietly and face forward • Keep hands and feet to yourself • Go to the washroom before an assembly 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enter gym quietly • Once seated with your class use whisper voices only • Clap politely • Use appropriate audience manners • Come empty handed • Stay seated on your bottom so others can see 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay quiet so others can hear • Put your finger to your mouth as a signal to others who need direction • Listen to and look at the speaker • Intermediate students set a positive example for primary students 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow the directions of the speaker • Focus on the speaker • Follow adult direction • Put up your hand and wait to speak 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a good listener • Appreciate the speaker with well timed polite applause • Enter the gym respectfully • Make eye contact
TECHNOLOGY/ CYBER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only visit websites approved by the teacher • Take care of the equipment so others can enjoy their use too 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cell phones stay in backpacks for the day and while on school property • Only publish/post things that are positive 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean up technology without asking • Help others stay on task • Use technology correctly even when no one is looking 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only use language you feel comfortable saying in person • Stay on proper or assigned sites 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use two hands when carrying technology • Keep four on the floor • Keep food and liquid at a distance • Put technology away properly
