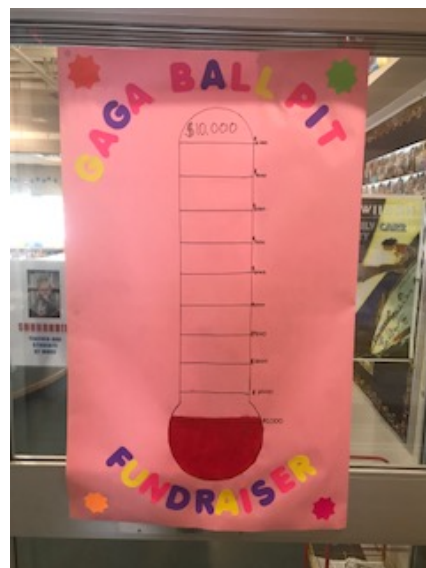


PAC Updates
