Evans Parent Week at a Glance

Hello Evans parents, it has been my custom at other school's to send parents an email each week to provide information and a reminder for events that are happening at the school. I must apologies as I attempted to send this on the weekend and it did not reach parents via email. Hopefully you will receive this copy.

While we are not generally able to have parents inside the school at this time in their typical roles (PAC, volunteers, helpers, school events, etc.) we do want to keep you informed of all that is happening at the school.

Updated Bell Schedule

Our school will have some changes in the bell schedule to accommodate a 2 week spring break this year for families and studen ts. Hopefully parents received this information in June of last school year. This fall we have needed to further adjust the bell schedule at recess and lunch based on having students in learning cohorts under the STAGE 2 School Restart Plan. Our bell schedule this y ear is as follows:

Entry & Dismissal Bells
8:00 Warning Bell, students are brought into the school to wash hands
8:05 Start of Instructional Day
2:05 Dismissal Bell End of Instructional Day
Please do not arrive at the school before the start of supervision which is 7:50am

• Play areas for each cohort are separated and are rotated by cohort group throughout the week

Drop Off & Pick-up

As was mentioned in a previous email we are asking parents help in changing the process for drop off and pick-up of students to ensure social distancing during these times. We are hoping that parents of children in grades 1 - 5 can help us as follows:

Morning Drop Off

In the morning when students are arriving at school we ask that they not arrive before 7:50am and then go directly to their a ssigned line-up locations so that there is no mixing of students in different learning cohort groups. For parents who walk their child to school we ask that you remain behind the fenced area at the front or on the "track area" if you walk your child to the side of the school. For parents who drive their children we ask that you drop and leave after ensuring your child is safely off the parking lot or driveway areas.

Afternoon Pick-Up

For parents who are who walking their child home from school we ask that you arrange to meet your child behind the fenced are a at the front of the school or on the "track area" to the side of the school. For parents who drive their children, we ask that you remain in your vehicles in the front driveway or side parking lot leaving only briefly to ensuring your child gets safety into the vehicle.

We thank you so much for your help and support with this plan. We have made it a priority to ensure that all students are as safe as possible at all times during the day including coming to and from school.
