<u>Student Photo Day</u> – We will have our student photo day on the morning of October 20<sup>th</sup>. We will send information home on picture packages available in the next little while. While we can do individual pictures this year we are unable to take class photos at this time.

**Non Instructional Day** – Just a reminder that this Friday (October 23<sup>rd</sup>) is a Non Instructional Day with no school for students.

**Lockdown Drill** – On Tuesday, October 27<sup>th</sup> (in the afternoon) Evans Elementary School will be conducting a lockdown drill. The purpose of this drill is to practice with staff and students the lockdown procedures in the event we need to perform a lockdown to secure the school in the future. The procedures we will use were developed by the RCMP and the school district. We will discuss this in each of the classrooms in advance of the drill, but wanted to make parents aware this was happening and was only a precautionary practice.

**Early Dismissal & Mid-Term Reporting** – On October 29<sup>th</sup> we will have an early dismissal at 11:05am for the purpose of Mid-Term Reporting. Teachers will provide parents a mid-term report on their child at some point in this week. These reports are intended to be informal and to connect parents with where there child is currently in their learning. Should you have any questions about your child's progress or wish further information please don't hesitate to get in touch with your child teachers. Even in COVID time teachers are always happy to discuss with you your child's progress in a phone call.

**<u>Orange & Black Theme Day</u>** – We are encouraging students to wear orange and black on our Orange & Black Theme Day.

<u>VIRTUAL Christmas Concert</u> – This year we are planning on putting on a virtual Christmas Concert this year. This would mean that students would be video taped and a performance would be streamed for parents to watch. Should you wish for your child to be part of the "taped" concert that parents can watch, we will need to have a signed consent form that allows us to video tape your child. If you are unsure if you have completed this form please check with you child's teacher.

**Focus on Friendliness** – In the Month of October we are having students focus on being friendly and being a good friend. As part of this we will be doing a **Bucket Fill event(Oct 19<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>)**. We want to have students "catch each other" in acts of Friendliness and Friendship. We will have a forms that students can fill out for each other and place into a bucket when they catch another students doing an act that is Friendly. For the younger students (K-1) staff will be helping here. We will then do a draw at different points in the week with both the nominated child and the nominee winning a prize. This event will "kick off" at an assembly on October 19<sup>th</sup> (With the Book <u>Have You Filled a Bucket Today</u>)
