Lockdown Drill – On Monday, October 18th Evans Elementary School will be conducting a lockdown drill. The purpose of this drill is to practice with staff and students the lockdown procedures in the event we need to perform a lockdown to secure the school in the future. The procedures we will use were developed by the RCMP and the school district. We will discuss this in each of the classrooms in advance of the drill, but wanted to make parents aware this was happening and was only a precautionary practice

Student Photo Day – We will have our student photo day on the morning of October 19th.

Non Instructional Day – Just a reminder that this Friday (October 22nd) is a Non Instructional Day with no school for students

PAC Hot Lunches - PAC wants to let you know that we have officially launched our Munchalunch Online Ordering Portal. Munchalunch is an online service that allows us to collect hot lunch and fundraising orders online. The idea is no more digging for change or lost forms at the bottom of backpacks!

Of course this means some changes to the way you pay now. Munchalunch allows you to pay via credit card and Visa debit. The PAC will still accept payment via cash and check, if you need to. But orders must be submitted through Munchalunch regardless. We will no longer be handing out paper forms for hot lunches, and most fundraisers. Please note that if you do plan on handing in a cash or check payment, to the office, it is **IMPERATIVE** that the payment include a note stating: Student Name, Teacher Name, and which lunches are being paid for. We will use this information to cross reference with Munchalunch. Thank you for your cooperation with this.

Hot lunch orders and payments are now due **seven days** before the hot lunch date. PAC will send home a reference sheet at the beginning of each hot lunch session with these dates for you to keep at home. You may submit multiple orders at once but don't need to pay for them all at once, unless you want to. But please ensure payment is in on time, for each lunch, in order to avoid cancellation of the order.

Before ordering on Munchalunch you will need to set up a profile. Each profile can have more than one child if you have multiple in the school. Please follow the appropriate link below to set up your profile:
