(Repeat) Checking in at the Office – Just a friendly reminder that ***ALL parents MUST check in at the office*** even if they are only entering the school briefly. We value the safety of the children very much and this will help ensure this at all times during the school day. Thanks for your help with this.

Daily Health Checks – All families **MUST** still complete a daily health check with their child BEFORE sending them to school each day. **Children who show any symptoms of illness MUST** remain home until they are symptom free. (Repeat) Parking by the School Entrance (on the curb) - We have been asked to remind parents **not to park on the curb marked in yellow at the entrance to the school**. This often happens at the end of the day and is impeding vehicles from entering the school parking lot safely. In the event of an emergency, first responders may not be able to access the building with vehicles parked there. Thanks for your help with this.

(Repeat) Are You Moving ? – We are currently planning for the 2022—23 school year. If you are planning on moving or believe your child may not be at Evans next year, we would appreciate you letting the office (annette_morelli@sd33.bc.ca) know. While this does not need to be a firm commitment, it will help us in planning for next year.

(Repeat) Kindergarten Registration - If you have a child who turns 5 years old in 2022 (or know someone who does) it is time to register them for Kindergarten at Evans. Our classes are starting to fill up and we want to ensure students have a space. Our Kindergarten program offers:

- A play-based learning approach where we “learn to play and play to learn”
- Time in outdoor play, exploration and discovery that allows children to use all of their senses
- ABC Bootcamp: full immersion of the alphabet to build / create a strong literacy foundation
- Oral language development through literature, games and music
- Strong relationships with families and excellent communication between the school and home
