**Updated Sports Day Plan (June 20<sup>th</sup>)** – I wanted to give parents an update on Sports Day this year which will take place June 20<sup>th</sup>. ***This year parents will be able to join us for this event outdoors.*** As we are still working on the details our **TENTATIVE** plan for the days is as follows:

We will include further details on our Sports Day shortly (by email and in the final WAG) as we finished planning these events. We will have an "inside" activity day for students in the event of rain or inclement weather ***however, our inside capacity limits will likely not allow us to include parents should events need to be moved indoors due to weather.*** The decision on an indoor or outdoor event will take place by 7:30 am on June 20<sup>th</sup> and will be communicated to parents by email.

**(Repeat) Are You Moving ?** – We are currently planning for the 2022—23 school year. While this does not need to be a firm commitment, it will help us in planning for next year.

**(Repeat) Kindergarten Registration** - If you have a child who turns 5 years old in 2022 (or know someone who does) it is time to register them for Kindergarten at Evans. Our classes are starting to fill up and we want to ensure students have a space. Our Kindergarten program offers:

- A play-based learning approach where we “learn to play and play to learn”
- Time in outdoor play, exploration and discovery that allows children to use all of their senses
- ABC Bootcamp: full immersion of the alphabet to build / create a strong literacy foundation
- Oral language development through literature, games and music
- Strong relationships with families and excellent communication between the school and home
