<u>School Supplies for 2023 – 24 School Year -</u> We want to let you know our plan for student school supplies for the 2023 - 24 school year. In order to streamline the process and minimize costs to families, we are working with a supplier to bulk ordering supplies and will be asking families to pay *\$45.00 to cover supplies for your child for the entire school year*. This is consistent with the current practice of many elementary schools around the Chilliwack School District. For classes that use a planner, there will be an additional \$8.00 cost. In September, your child's teacher will be in touch with you to collect funds for school supplies. Should this present a hardship for your family, please speak with your child's teacher at that time.

For parents who wish to purchase their own supplies, we will post a "generic" supply list in mid-June. Please note that <u>these lists are not all inclusive</u> and individual teachers may ask for additional supplies in the fall once classes have been determined. We encourage parents to let us do the shopping or wait until classes are set before purchasing supplies.
