Some Tips

- Review the flyer with your child ahead of time and plan which books you want to buy
- Send the flyer with circled items (or a paper list) in a Ziploc bag with cash or a cheque.
 Helpers can assist your child in getting the books you planned to purchase.
- Please make cheques out to Evans Elementary School
- There are fun items like posters, erasers and bookmarks. Please discuss how many of these items your child can purchase or how much money your child can spend on these items.

Other Notes

- On both Wednesday and Thursday, each class will have the opportunity to come down to the library. ONLY students with money will go shopping.
- Credit Cards/ Debit will be accepted (for afterschool shopping only)
- The Book Fair will be closed at recess and lunch
- Regular library classes will be cancelled. Students can keep books for 2 weeks or bring them
 to the 'return' bin at school after one week.
